



ANNUAL BONSPIEL – Wednesday March 29 to Sunday April 2, 2017

The Bonspiel starts Wednesday March 29th with one draw at 7:30 pm;
Thursday – March 30th, one draw at 7:30 pm;
Friday - March 31st, two draws: 5:30 pm, (Calcutta begins at 7:30 pm), 9:00 pm;
Saturday - April 1st, Six draws: 9:00 & 11:15 am, 1:30 pm, (ICE CLEANING) 4:30 pm, 6:45 pm, 9:00 pm;
Sunday - April 2nd, three draws: 9:00 am, 11:30 am (Hot Shots finals at 2:00 pm), FINALS 3:00 pm

The Hot Shots elimination round is immediately following your first game, on the same sheet.

BANQUET and PRESENTATION OF PRIZES – 5:30 PM SUNDAY

Additional meals, over the 4 per team provided, are available for \$20 each; see the Draw Master to reserve early.

TO ALL PRIZE WINNERS; TEAM MEMBERS MUST BE PRESENT TO PICK THEIR PRIZE. Team mates can pick up a prize for missing members after selections are complete.

In the interest of friendly competition, the following rules shall apply during the bonspiel. Please follow them.
**In order to speed up play without having to rush, be ready to shoot before you are required to; also, it is not necessary to pull out the next shooter's rock.

With the exception of the following, the C.C.A. Rules of Curling For General Play - 2014 to 2018 shall be in effect.

Regulation games shall be eight ends in length. A game that is tied following regulation play shall have a winner declared by a **FULL** extra end played towards the glass. If the extra end is blanked, a winner shall be declared by Draw Shot Distance per regular season Exceptional Rules.

Penalties for a late start are as follows;

- a) Up to ten minutes late – offending team loses one point, one end, the hammer and choice of rock colour.
- b) Ten to twenty minutes late – offending team losses two points, two ends, hammer and choice of rock colour.
- c) After twenty minutes – the game is forfeited.

No three-man rink may play in the semi-final or final games. Only regular team members and registered spares are eligible to play. If a non-team spare is required he is to be appointed/approved by the Draw Master.

Vice Skips only are to be in the house for rock measurements.

Deliberate delay or 'stalling' shall not be allowed and the offending team shall forfeit the game.

In all cases of dispute the decision of the referee shall be final. The bonspiel referee will be the Draw Master or his designate.

Tables will be numbered to correspond to the ice on which you have just played. Please vacate the numbered tables before the next group of curlers finishes their game.
